

2020 Member Safety Agreement

“Stepping Towards Normal”

Valley Points Family YMCA

The Valley Points Family YMCA is committed to keeping the health and safety of our members and staff our top priority. We have instituted new policies as part of our stepping stones back to normalcy. Step 1 (see below) will be the strictest phase and will span through at least the end of June. We will lesson our policy measures as we move into Step 2 and Step 3 if, and only if, national and state guidelines permit us to do so. Please read through the Step 1 policies below and sign our agreement stating that you are committing to help us ensure the safest environment possible for our Y family. For the protection of everyone in our facilities, all members will be expected to sign and abide by the following policies when in any of our branches:

1. To keep yourself and others safe, all members will be required to wear a mask in the common areas of our facilities. Wearing a mask in our workout areas is encouraged. Wearing a mask during intense cardio or while swimming is not recommended.
2. To prevent the spread of communicable diseases, including COVID-19, temperatures will be taken upon each entrance to our facilities. Any person with a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher will not be permitted to enter.
3. All check-ins will be no contact. Members will be asked to swipe their own membership cards or verbally communicate their information to our welcome center staff.
4. After check-in, members will be asked to sanitize their hands before further entering the facility.
5. In order to ensure your space in our facility while we are required to lower our occupancy numbers, first priority will be given to members with reservations. Reservations can be made 24 hours in advance through online registration at vpfymca.org, by phone or in person at one of our welcome centers. If you do not have a reservation, and our facility is filled to capacity, our welcome center will assist you in making an appointment for the next available time. After check-in at the welcome center, you will be checked in again by a Y staff member at the area of your reservation.
6. Please abide by the 6-foot rule for social distancing at all times in our facilities so that you and your fellow members will feel as comfortable as possible in their own personal space.
7. All members are required to wipe equipment both before and after use. YMCA staff will also be cleaning equipment between each appointment to provide the cleanest environment possible.
8. Each member will need to leave the building directly after their scheduled appointment concludes. Our intent is to be able to track and notify any member that might have come in contact with someone testing positive for COVID-19. In order for this to be possible, the building must be cleared before the next appointment is permitted to enter.
9. Please arrive no more than five minutes prior to your scheduled appointment. This will give our staff enough time to clean after the previous appointment and be ready to assist you upon entering.
10. Members will be directed to a separate door for exiting the building in order to ease the flow of traffic and provide for proper social distancing.
