WELCOME!

Welcome to Summer Camp at the Valley Points Family YMCA! Camp, like many Y programs, is about learning skills, developing character, and making friends. Our program includes a focus on caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility in all activities. Kids have fun while trained staff members guide them through daily schedules that nurture their spirits, challenge their minds, and strengthen their bodies. Weekly themes keep kids engaged while learning about themselves and the world around them.

Summer Camp provides an exciting, safe community for children ages 5–12 (children must have completed Kindergarten) to build self–esteem, develop interpersonal skills, and make lasting friendships and memories.

COUNSELORS IN TRAINING (CIT)

Youth ages 13–15 can participate in Summer Camp as CITs, assisting staff with younger children and building leadership skills. The CIT program gives teens age–appropriate challenges that help build skills, confidence, and capacity for working with people of all ages.

GETTING READY FOR CAMP

- Children should bring a healthy, well-rounded brown bag lunch; Breakfast & Snack provided. (Refrigeration is provided. Exception: Pack a <u>non-perishable lunch</u> on field trip days.)
- Scheduled activities (including SWIMMING) vary per site.
- · Parents are responsible for transportation to and from camp.
- All locations are open 7am to 6pm.
- Parents are responsible for payment the days that your child is registered, regardless of actual attendance.
- All balances will be drafted from your checking, savings, or credit card account on the Friday prior to the week attending.
